Co-op postgraduate study options



- Graduate Certificate in Co-operative Management and Organisation (4 courses, comprising 3 specialised Coop courses and 1 elective course)
- MBA with Specialisation in Co-operatives and Social Enterprises Management (8 MBA courses + 4 courses as from Grad Cert in Coop)
- 3. Any of the 3 specialised Co-op courses can be taken as a one-off **non-award courses**.

3 Specialised Co-op Courses



The Graduate Certificate is offered as an ONLINE part-time study, ie only one course per trimester.

- GSBS6411 Introduction to Co-operative Organisation and Management (10 points) (offered in trimester 1)
- LEGL 6005 Co-operative Law and Governance (10 points) (offered in trimester 2)
- GSBS6412 Social enterprises and Co-operative Innovation (10 points) (offered in trimester 3)
